

# KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!

## IF POLICE COME TO YOUR HOUSE



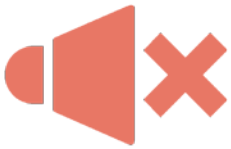
### DO NOT OPEN DOORS

- ICE can only enter a home IF THEY HAVE A SIGNED WARRANT OR UNLESS YOU LET THEM IN.
- Do not open the door until you have PHYSICALLY seen the warrant
- Make sure to tell them to pass the warrant under the door before you let them in.



### REPORT THE RAID

- Call our immigration hotline at 404-890-5655
- Take pictures if you can do so safely. You have the right to take pictures.
- Document the incident as thoroughly as possible including the name, badge numbers and physical descriptions of the law enforcement officers.



### REMAIN SILENT

- You have the right to REMAIN SILENT - Say "I plead the fifth amendment and choose to remain silent"
- Anyone in police custody must be told four things before being questioned by the police (It's your Miranda Warning):
  1. You have the right to remain silent.
  2. Anything you say can and will be used against you in a court of law.
  3. You have the right to an attorney.
  4. If you cannot afford an attorney, one will be appointed for you



### DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING

- DO NOT SIGN PAPERS ICE may give you without first speaking with an attorney
- Find a trusted lawyer to help your case.
